With three single-seaters and three prototypes, GRAFF wants to finish the year on a high in the Ultimate Cup Series in Paul Ricard.

Single Seaters

As Paul Trojani will race for the overall title in the single-seaters challenge, GRAFF is happy to welcome alongside him Enzo Richer, 8th in the French F4 championship standings, who will make his debuts with the Tatuus FT318 #66.

In collaboration with WINFIELD RACING SCHOOL, GRAFF hosts the racing school, which will provide technical support for car #44, driven by Ukrainian driver Yaroslav Veselaho.

Prototypes

GRAFF will run two LMP3 Ligier JSP320. The #65 will be driven by a well-known duo as Australians Fraser Ross and George Nakas, coming from Michelin le Mans Cup, will make their debuts in Ultimate Cup Series.

LMP3 #16 will showcase drivers coming from Ligier European Series with Greeks Georgios Kolovos and Panagiotis Kaitatzis. They will be joined by Louis Rossi, returning to GRAFF after joining the team for the Ultimate Cup Series finale last year.

Last but not least, GRAFF is happy to announce its first race with the Nova NP02 which will be driven by three drivers well-known from the team: Eric Trouillet, Luis Sanjuan and David Droux.
