

GRAFF ENTER ROAD TO LE MANS WITH ONE LMP3



GRAFF is pleased to announce the entry of one LMP3 car in Road to le Mans, as a support race for the 24 Hours of le Mans.

Driving our LMP3 Ligier JSP320 #9, GRAFF will be reunited with local racer Louis Rossi, who will race for the first time on the four-wheel 24H circuit. In his biking career, Louis has raced 7 times in the Motorcycle 24 Hours race, claiming a podium in 2018. Louis has a good history with GRAFF with three podiums in three races, both in NP02 and LMP3.

Chinese driver, Luo Haowen, will join Louis Rossi for the event. He already raced in Road to le Mans in 2023 with GRAFF alongside Sébastien Page. Since then, Haowen raced in Super Trofeo Asia and was a podium finisher in the 12 Hours of Shanghai.

This is an opportunity to discover this circuit with the idea of racing in the 24 Hours one day, which is the goal of any racing driver."*

Road to le Mans will see two races of 55 minutes on the 24 Hours of le Mans race track, on Thursday June 13th and Saturday June 15th before the 24 Hours of le Mans.
